

# Marlborough Enduro 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> April 2021

## Supplementary Information

### Location

Kemps property, 3938 state highway 1, 10ks south of Blenheim, signed from SH1. Camping is available on site. There will be a trail ride held on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> using most of the Enduro circuit.

Enduro **entry** \$150 for two days or \$80 per day. Enter on the day.

*Trail Ride – Monday 26<sup>th</sup> - \$20 kids, \$40 adults 16+, Family \$60 (2 kids, 1 adult – or 1 kid free)*

### Enduro Start order:

Rider numbers will be issued on the day.

1 to 15 will be reserved for AA course (Expert) riders in order of sign on.

(3 riders per minute e.g. Minute 1 = Rider numbers 1, 1a and 1b, minute 2 = Rider numbers 2, 2a, 2b etc.)

Numbers 16 to 36b will be reserved for A course riders in order of sign on.

Numbers from 37 + will be issued at the discretion of the organisers on the day.

### Saturday – Standard Time Card Enduro

**Sign on 7:30am to 9:30am**

Riders briefing 9:40am

1<sup>st</sup> riders away at 10:00am

**Sunday – Enduro Sprint.** This will be a standard time card enduro but with loose timing and extended terrain tests.

**Sign on 10:00am to 11:30am**

Rider briefing 11:45am

1<sup>st</sup> riders enter the impound start 12:00pm

Start Check opens 12:15pm

### Event points structure

Riders will receive 'double points' for the two days. i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> = 50, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 40, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 36, 4<sup>th</sup> = 32, etc (See MNZ *Off Road Rule* 6.14a)

Riders who finish only one day will be scored single day points and placed behind those who complete 2 days as follows and contrary to rule 14.5i.

#### **Finisher - 2 days**

Finisher – Saturday, Starts Sunday but DNF.

Finisher – Saturday (Enters impound), DNS Sunday

*Riders must have an MNZ Championship Licence in order to be eligible to compete for points in any class of the NZ Enduro Championship. Riders can enter the event with Club or an MNZ Day Licence but will be placed in the event but will not be awarded points towards the championship series.*

#### **Parc ferme - AA riders only.**

Riders who enter classes competing on the AA course (Expert) for the 2-days will be required to push their motorcycle into the impound area after the final check on Saturday and will not have access to their motorcycle until 15 minutes before their start time on Sunday morning.

The impound will be secure stock yards with a marshals monitoring continuously. The impound will not be left unattended at any time while bikes are impounded. MNZ insurance will cover any impounded and otherwise uninsured motorcycle in the event of theft or fire.

Riders can opt not to check their bike into the impound and receive a 4000 point penalty.

#### **Work periods**

**Day 1, Saturday** - The final trail stage will end at the pit area where there will be a pre-pit check point. This will be the final check for the **A** and **B** course competitors who will **not** be required to impound their motorcycles. The final check for **AA** course will open 15 minutes after the pit entry check, i.e. riders have 15 minutes to complete any work and maintenance before pushing their motorcycle to the final check and then into the impound (Rule 14.7b and rule 14.3s).

**Day2, Sunday** – Riders will be admitted to the impound area. Riders will have 15 minutes to collect their motorcycle, move it to the impound work area and then to the start check point. For more information see MNZ off road rules chapter 14. clause 14.5 rules 14.5a to 14.5l.

#### **Results**

Preliminary results will be displayed at the completion of the event. Official results will be published on **silver-bullet.co.nz** and the protest period notified on **mnz.co.nz** after which the protest period will start. (Rule 7.2.2f ). If no protests are received after 2 days the results will stand. See Enduro 2021 supplementary regulations.
